Capacity Building Programmes for Teachers

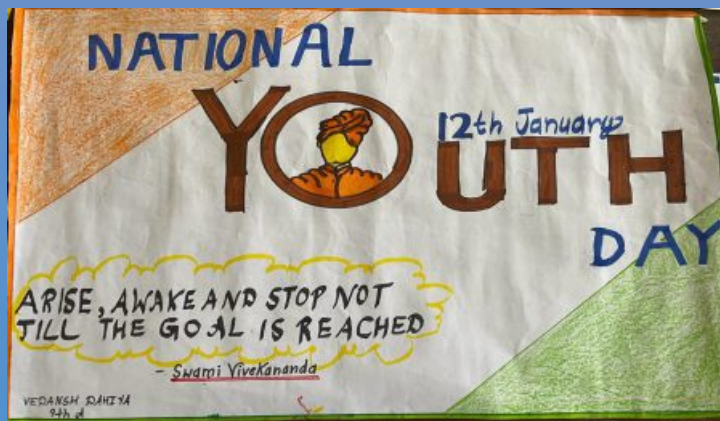
